Collection of Data

Generally our public event activities fall into two categories.

- a. Raffles and similar events such as a Duck Race

The data controller for these events will be Thatcham and District Rotary Club.

The data protection officer will be the club secretary. E mail address

The data collected for these type of events may include, name, address, e mail address, and telephone number.

The information is collected to be able to communicate with the winners to distribute prizes.

Winner's names may be displayed on our website and shared with news media for reporting on the event and notification of winners.

The information which may have been supplied in either paper or electronic format will be securely disposed of following the successful distribution of the prizes.

- b. Participation events such as Santa Run, Car Show, or similar events.

The data controller for these events will be Thatcham and District Rotary Club.

The data protection officer will be the club secretary. E mail address

The data collected for these type of events may include, name, age range, address, e mail address and telephone number.

The information is collected to be able to communicate event details or changes, determine entry fee, provide differing sizes of outfits, and notify winners if applicable.

Winner's names may be displayed on our website and shared with news media for reporting on the event and notification of winners.

Only contact details are retained to enable notification of future events, all other information which may have been supplied in either paper or electronic format will be securely disposed of following the close out of the completed event.

Payment Collection Providers

Payments/donations for events are often collected through providers such as "Just Giving", "MyDonate", and "Paypal" etc. These organisations collect personal data to enable the payments to be made and we will receive payment reports from them. Each of these organisations will have their own Privacy Statement available from their websites.

Photographs

At many of our events photographs are taken to enable reporting on the event either through our website or shared with the news media. Photographs may also be used to publicise future events.

Individual children will only be photographed and used with the guardian's permission.

Your Rights

The provision of personal data is a requirement of entering the events/competitions.

You have the right to request from the controller access to and rectification or erasure of Personal data or restriction of processing concerning you or to object to processing.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the ICO.

There is no automated-decision making on your personal data by the Club
